“Honeydew is a modern-day Hansel and Gretel narrative that follows two relatively opposite lovers through a strange and dark world, which offers the more-seeking of the two an opportunity to veer off the course and follow his impulses without judgment or consequences—or so he thinks.

The film asks, and in some ways answers, can you have your cake and eat it too?

Is the cake that good?

Do you really want to eat that cake?

This piece, in all of its absurdity, is one that is truly close to my heart and, I think, reflective of a real human dilemma.”
